					time. An "enzyme unit" (U) is frequently defined as the amount of enzyme that catalyses the conversion of substrate per minute under specified conditions. Enzymes speed up reactions by lowering the activation energy. They often use an "induced fit" mechanism, where the enzyme changes shape slightly to bind the substrate more tightly. Enzyme activity is regulated by inhibitors or activators. Specific activity, measured in units per milligram of protein (U/mg), indicates the purity of an enzyme preparation.
