The Secretary (HE) welcomed all the members and informed that the 'Har Ghar Jhanda' programme has been approved by the National Implementation Committee (NIC) of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) and this has been deliberated upon by the Committee of Secretaries (CoS) under then Chairmanship of the Cabinet Secretary. - The students would be facilitated to know/acknowledge the importance of freedom as well as the struggle by freedom fighters to achieve this freedom. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by the AICTE with the veterans of India, in which,

Military Officer of any level share their experience in schools and colleges, may be leveraged for this. A week before Independence week, essay competition, drawing competition and singing competition may be organized in Schools and colleges to build tempo among students.

- 6. The Ministry of Culture will be requested to provide a list of Do's and Don'ts related to hoisting of National Flag, so that it can be circulated to the students. Further, the website developed for uploading photos, etc. by the students may also be requested for.
- 7. Different websites maintained by the Autonomous Bodies as well as the Ministry will have this information prominently displayed through banners, etc.
- 8. Modalities are being worked out with the stakeholders for availability of the National Flag for as little as Rs. 20-30/- per piece.
